Sand Change

- Turn off the pool pump.
 (Above Ground Pool: plug off return and skimmer)
- 2. Only on top mounted multi-ports: cut the PVC so that you can remove the multi-port from the top of the filter tank.
- 3. Dip out the sand or use a shop-vac to remove the sand. (Be careful not to damage the laterals in the bottom of the filter tank!). Unscrew the laterals to clean and examine them for cracks or holes.
- 4. Replace the laterals and cover the center pipe so that sand does not get into the center pipe. Look at the label on the outsid3e of the tank to see how much sand (media) is required. Fill the tank with 12 inches of water. Fill the tank with silica sand (NOT play sand).
- 5. Replace the multi-port and clamp. Repair the PVC with slip fittings or unions.
- 6. BACKWASH and RINSE the pool so that the very fine particles of sand in each bag will pass out into the yard and not into the pool.
