Consulting

Over his 25 year consulting career, Mr. Korczyk has led numerous multi-billion dollar valuations of companies in connection with some of the largest business transactions in the U.S. and around the world. He is known for and frequently sought out to undertake complex assignments calling for sophisticated financial analysis and unique skills. Examples of consulting projects include:

- Performed regulatory services on behalf of a large triple-play legacy cable operator (MSO), resulting in risk mitigation, improvements to cost recovery processes, and materially enhanced profit margins.
