



Advanced Shoring

This course focuses on shoring of heavier and more complex buildings and loads.

The Advanced Shoring course is a 4 day – 40 hour program developed by the FEMA Instructors and subject matter experts for encompassing structural collapse training for assessing and mitigating all types of collapses in all types of buildings to facilitate advanced shoring operations. Students are exposed to theory, principle and relationships of how and why collapse events occur and how they can best be addressed for successful and safe search and rescue operations. The training integrates elements of physics and engineering concepts and is heavily weighted with practical applications of shoring construction, shoring placement, shoring multiple stories and the stabilization of heavy objects in a safe and efficient manner facilitating victim rescue. The curriculum is for advanced shoring takes the basics of Structural Collapse Technician and applies them to multiple story collapse, confined spaces, truss construction and stabilizing heavy weigh buildings.
